What can Town/Parish Councils spend their portion of CIL on?

CIL funds must be used to support development. The proportion of CIL that a Town/Parish Council receives must be used to support the development of the area.

Funds can be spent on:

- the provision, improvement / replacement, operation or maintenance of infrastructure; or
- anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area.

This gives Town/Parish Councils considerable freedom to spend their proportion of CIL on the things that address the impacts of development on their area.

Examples include:

- Improvements to a village hall
- Improved play areas
- Provision of affordable housing
- Preparation of a Neighbourhood Plan (providing it addresses the demands that development places on the area).

Possible Projects:

- rejuvenating the Playground in Frampton Mansell. Younger families are now resident in the Parish.
- improving signage in Sapperton and Frampton Mansell re HGV vehicle movements
