Direction restricting permitted development

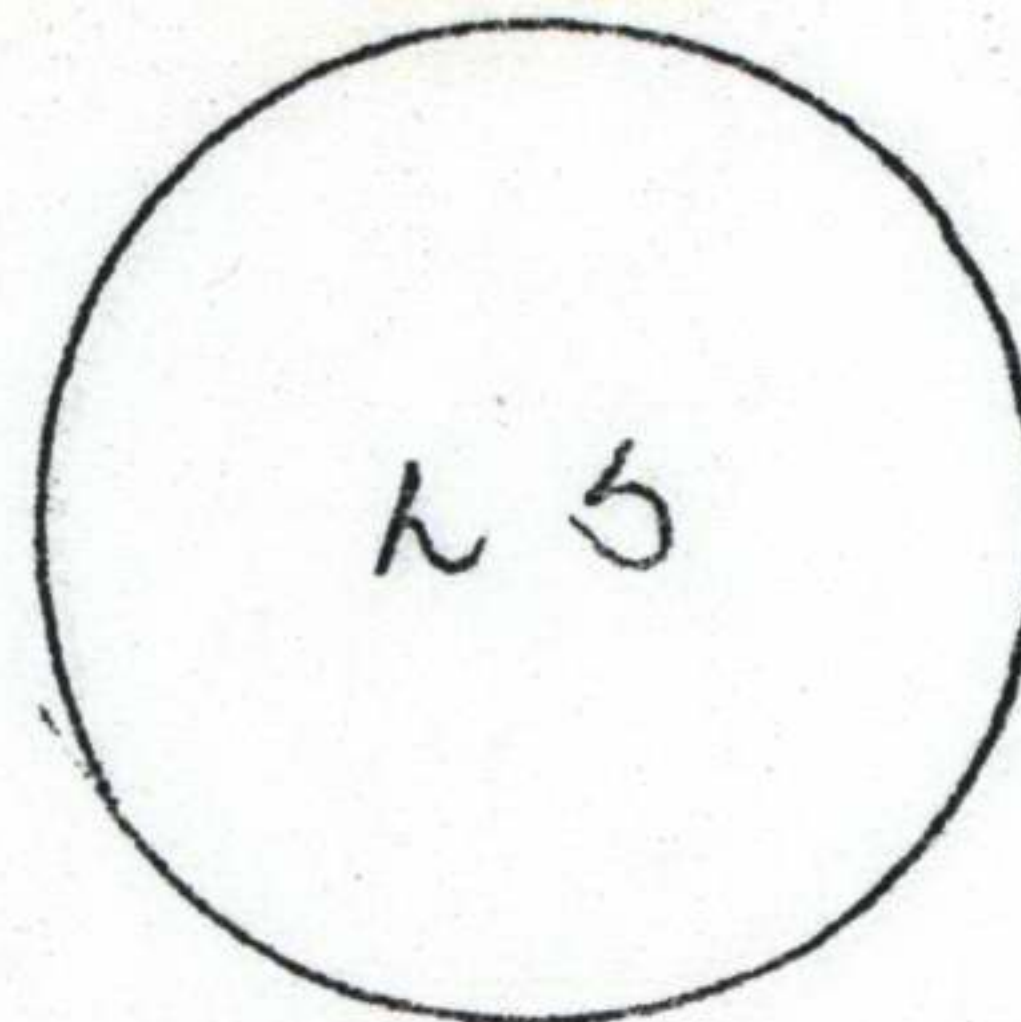
WHEREAS GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL being the Local Planning Authority are satisfied that it is expedient that the development set out in the schedule hereto should not be carried out on land being Parcel Numbers 4100, 6628, 6927, 7122, 5200, 6911, 7413, 7516 and 0647 and Part Parcels 8800 and 2760 Ordnance Survey Sheets ST.7892-7992 and ST.7891-7991 (1972 Edn.) in the Parish of Ozleworth in the Tetbury Rural District and <sup>more particularly</sup> shown coloured pink on the plan attached hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the said land") unless permission is granted on an application in that behalf

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the said development.

SCHEDULE

The erection of agricultural buildings being development <sup>comprised within paragraph</sup> specified <sup>1 of</sup> ~~is~~ Class VI of Schedule 1 to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973. <sup>and not being development comprised within any other class.</sup>

LAND AT OZLEWORTH

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 5th November, 1973, the Secretary of State for the Environment approved a Direction made by the Gloucestershire County Council pursuant to Article 4 of the above-mentioned Order in respect of land being Parcel Nos. 4100; 6628; 6927; 7122; 5200; 6911; 7413; 7516; and 0647 and Part Parcels 8800 and 2760 Ordnance Survey Sheet ST.7892-7992 and ST.7891-7991 (1972 Edition) in the Parish of Ozleworth in the Tetbury Rural District.

The affect of the Direction is that the permission granted by Article 3 of the above-mentioned Order shall not apply to development on this land for erection of agricultural buildings being development comprised within paragraph 1 of Class VI of Schedule I to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1973 and not being development comprised within any other Class and that accordingly permission must be obtained from the Gloucestershire County Council as Local Planning Authority before any such development is carried out.

A copy of the said Direction and of the Map defining the area to which it relates may be seen during normal office hours at the Shire Hall, Gloucester.
