TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT

ORDER 1977

WHEREAS THE COUNCIL FOR THE BOROUGH OF TEWKESBURY (hereinafter called "the Council") being the Local Planning Authority for the said Borough of Tewkesbury are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on any land situate at Coldwell Bottom and Cowley Banks in the Parish of Cowley which said land is shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto, unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto.

THE SCHEDULE above referred to

The provisions of Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 shall not apply to development to the following class, being class specified in Schedule 1 of the said Order:-

Class VI Agricultural Buildings, Works and Uses.
